- ⊕ There are 35 Solo events and 14 Group events. Therefore, a total of 49 events to help you realize your interest and potential.
- ⊕ Participants are free to participate in any of the events.
- ⊕ Exact time of different events will be declared in due course of time. Notification about the events shall be sent on Aakanksha Website. Participants are advised to check the notice board, Instagram page, and Aakanksha website regularly for updates.
- ⊕ Audition round of all the events will take place at New Lecture Theater Complex, I.Sc, BHU.
- ⊕ Only participants will be responsible for the safety and safely handling their makeup bag, costumes, or any other luggage and electronics devices they bring to the venue of the event.
- ⊕ Participants are required to report to the venue of the event at least 30 minutes in advance along with their Identity card or student's passbook in order to avoid all sorts of inconvenience in their participation.
- ⊕ **NOTE:** In case of group events, the I-card/student's passbook of the Group leader is not enough. Each participant must bring his/her I-card/student's passbook with him/her.
- ⊕ In case of Group events, only the allowed number of Group members should be included; otherwise, all the extra inclusion will be cancelled, and those participants will not be allowed to participate.

Solo Events

Music

❖ Classical Vocal Solo

- Cinema songs are not allowed under this item.
- Judgement will be based on qualities like taal, selection of raga, composition and general impression.

❖ Film Solo Song

- No remix songs are permitted.
- Participants can use karaoke mode USB drives (No CDs).
- Accompanists will be available only in final round.

❖ Instrumental Non- Percussion

- Participants must bring their own instrument.
- Time for stage/instrument setting is maximum 5 minutes.
- Keyboard/Synthesizer not allowed.
- Judgement will be based on taal, rhythm, composition and general impression

❖ Instrumental Percussion

- Participants must bring their own instrument.
- Time for stage/instrument setting is maximum 5 minutes.
- Judgement will be based on taal, rhythm, composition and general impression.

❖ Light Vocal Solo

- Only non-film Songs/Geet/Ghazal/Bhajan/Shabad and Abhangas can be presented.
- Judgement will be based on qualities like taal, selection of raga, composition and general impression.
- Karaoke is not allowed in final rounds.

❖ **Western Vocal Solo**

- Language of song should only be English.
- Time for stage/instrument setting is 2 minutes.
- Judgement will be based on qualities like rhythm, coordination, and general impression.

Dance

❖ **Classical Dance Solo**

- USB Drives (No CDs) are allowed for the purpose of music.
- Classical Dance based on films are not allowed.
- Three copies of a brief note on the description of dance story involved in it, if any, and of the accompanying song, with its meaning in Hindi or English must be submitted at the time of registration.
- Judgement will be based on qualities like taal, technique, rhythm, expression, costumes, makeup, footwork, and general impression.

❖ **Bollywood Dance Solo**

- Dance based on remixes are permitted.
- Participant has to bring his/her own USB Drive (No CDs).
- Judgement will be based on qualities like costumes, movements, and expression.
- Dance based on classical film songs are not permitted.

❖ **Western Dance Solo**

- Recorded music from Western films, albums, tracks, remixes or live music from accompanists are allowed.
- USB Drives (No CDs) are allowed for the purpose of music.
- Judgement will be passed based on qualities like costumes, movement, and expression.
- Dance based on Indian films/albums/remixes are not allowed.

- The Dance should be based on some theme. Props are allowed.

- Judgement will be based on content and database, language and grammar, pronunciation and presentation.

- Judgement will be based on context, expression, and presentation.

- Judgement will be based on context, expression, and presentation.

- Medium shall be either English or Hindi only but not mixed.

- Participants may use Hindi or English language but not both.

Theatre

❖ **Mimicry**

- Participants may mimic sound of machines, speeches of well-known persons, animals or sounds heard in nature.
- It should be necessarily a cultured and pleasant piece of art.
- Medium of expression can be Hindi or English or both.
- Judgement will be based on qualities like skill in imitating, variety of sound and voices imitated, and presentation.

❖ **Stand-Up**

- Participants must perform original stand-up material.
- Medium of expression can be Hindi or English or both.
- Time limit for each performance is 5 to 7 minutes.
- Participants are required to refrain from using offensive or inappropriate language.
- Judgement will be based on humor, originality, delivery, timing, and audience engagement.
- No props, music, or background assistance is allowed during the performance.
- Participants must ensure their content is culturally appropriate and respectful.
- Participant must arrive 15 minutes before their performance slot for stage preparation.

- Stage properties are allowed.
- **No extra time** for setting will be given

Fine Arts

Note: Use of Mobile Phone will be strictly prohibited in all Fine Arts event except 'On the Spot Photography'.

❖ **On the Spot Painting**

- It will be conducted on the spot and participants will need to do painting on the subject given by the in-charge.
- Size of the paper will be 12 X 18 – inch paper.

- Painting can be done by oil, water, poster, or pastel color.
- Only paper will be provided.
- Participants will have to bring their own paint and brush.
- No wording except caption will be allowed.

❖ On the Spot Sketching

- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Size of the paper will be 12 X 18 – inch paper.

- Participants can bring one assistant on whom palm he /she can draw mehndi.

- Rangoli should be prepared within the space provided by the in-charge.

❖ On the Spot Photography

- The participant has to bring his/her own digital camera along with data transfer cable.
- The digital camera should have a memory card which will be formatted by judges before the commencement of the contest.
- The participant has to capture 5 photographs on the theme announced on the spot by the judges.
- **Mixing, matching or morphing of photos will not be permitted.**
- **Photo enhancing software such as Photoshop etc are not permitted.**
- The organizers will have all rights for the use of these pictures as and when they deem fit.
- Digital images will be evaluated on the basis of impact, composition, technical quality, suitability for the specific theme.

- Additional instructions, if any, will be announced on the spot.

- Photo submission must be original photos created by the Contestant and must not contain any elements that are protected by someone else's copyright or otherwise subject to third party proprietary rights, including privacy and publicity rights (cropping is permitted, as is modest darkening or lightening of parts of the image).
- Photo submission must not contain obscenity, explicit sexual material, graphic nudity, profanity, graphic violence, calls or incitement to violence, commercial solicitation, or commercial promotion. The content of all Photo submission must be suitable for a global public audience.

- Judges reserve the right to disqualify, or delete at their sole and absolute discretion, any submission that does not adhere to these criteria and to the intent and substance of our Contest Rules.
- The person submitting the photo will be considered the Contestant and will be the only person eligible to compete for the prize.

Music

❖ Group Song Indian

- Group song should be taken from Indian songs, which may be in regional language.
- Film songs are not allowed (except patriotic songs).
- A team has to present two songs, out of which one should be patriotic.
- Judgement will be based on the quality of singing only not on makeup, costumes, and action of the team.

- Language should only be English.
- Judgement will be based on the quality of singing only not on makeup, costumes, and action of the team.

Dance

❖ Folk/Tribal Dance

- Dance can either be primitive or a folk dance (Indian one) but not a classical one.
- Tracks from films having folk/tribal songs are not allowed.
- Three copies of a brief note giving the theme and the text of the song, if any, are to be submitted before the start of the event.
- Time for sets/instrument setting is maximum 5 minutes.

- Judgement will be based on rhythm, expression, costumes, and makeup.

- No remix songs are permitted.

- Accompanists will be available only in the final round.
- Duet performance are also allowed.

- It must reflect some theme and should be based on assorted music/song piece from **non-film/medleys or on the spot music.**

❖ Debate English

- Judgement will be based on qualities like content and database, language and grammar, contrast between the pair, pronunciation, body language, and presentation of both the candidates.

❖ Debate Hindi

- Participation is allowed only on pair, one candidate speaking for the motion and the other against the motion.
- Participants are supposed to stick to Hindi language only no English words should be used.

- Judgement will be based on qualities like content and database, language and grammar, contrast between the pair, pronunciation, body language, and presentation of both the candidates.

- Judgement will be based on qualities like content and database, language and grammar, contrast between the pair, pronunciation, body language, and presentation of both the candidates.

❖ **Drama**

- General furniture may be provided.
- Use of makeup, drapery, and background music allowed.
- Maximum time to set the stage will be 5 minutes per team, which will be in addition to the 30 minutes provided.
- Participating team should submit three copies of the synopsis of the theme of the play before the play.
- Judgement will be based on qualities of the play like theme, acting, stagecraft, music and overall impression.

- Accompanists can speak from background or will play musical instruments for background music. They shall never appear on stage.
